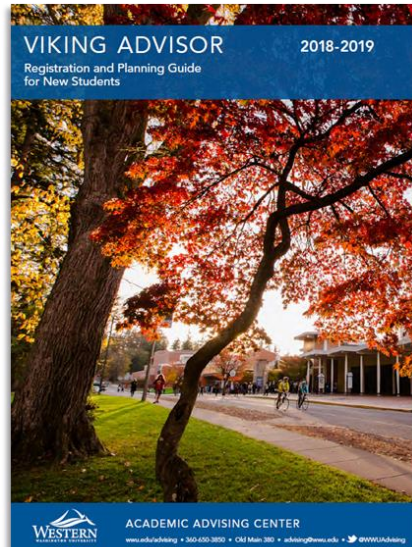


Registration Planning Tools

When registering or planning for your courses, there are many resources available. Four of these that are easily accessible include: the Viking Advisor, ClassFinder, TimeTable of Classes, and the Programs of Study.

Viking Advisor: Registration Guide for New Students

Provides information on what the General University Requirements, or GURs, are and how you can complete them.

The Viking Advisor also offers information on registration policies and instructions on how to register.

ClassFinder

This tool can be helpful when first planning your

Click on the CRN # to begin a scratch sheet of classes

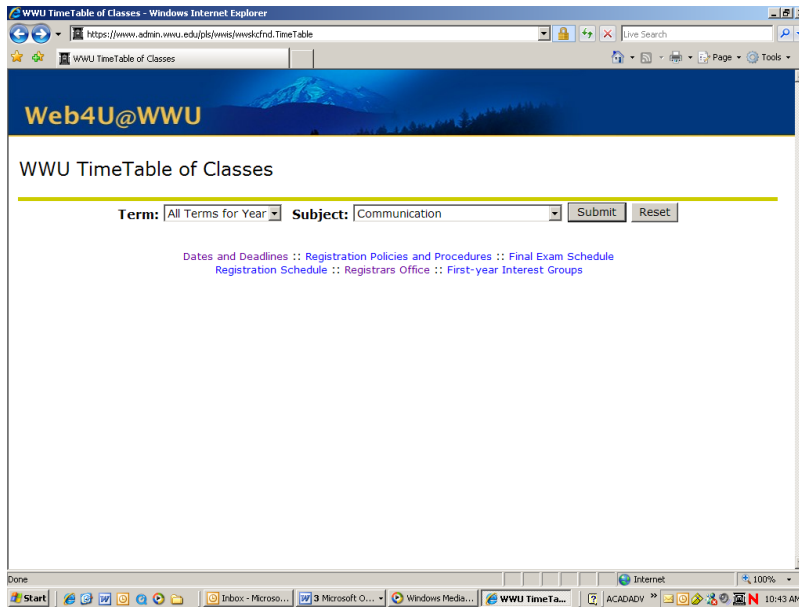
Informs you of any registration restrictions

You can search for classes by subject, GUR, open sections, instructor, and more. Be sure to note the prerequisites and restrictions that will affect your registration.

Use this tool to find out when your favorite classes are being offered. Plan your classes for the whole year!



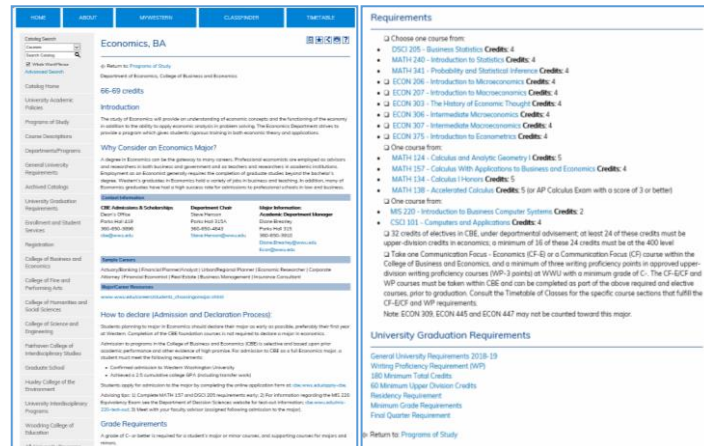
Very helpful with major specific courses, but not a great tool for looking up GURs.

You can also have direct access to the important Dates and Deadlines and Final Exam Schedule.

Programs of Study

Programs of Study are documents prepared by the Department to provide information on:

- How to declare the major
- Required credits and courses
- What GURs are available in the major
- What is the study of that subject
- Sample careers
- Departmental contacts



Use the Programs of Study to help you identify class options during registration. Be sure to watch for class prerequisites and plan accordingly. Meet with an advisor for more assistance.
