

Standing Committees of the Faculty Senate

ACC

The ACC is a major standing committee of the Faculty Senate whose members are charged with oversight of all aspects of the curriculum, curricular policy and Western's academic enterprise. Through its review ACC ensures curricular coherence, sets appropriate standards for student admission and progress through the curriculum, promotes the assessment of learning outcomes, and enforces guidelines for graduation requirements. UPRC

The UPRC examines resource implications for major changes in academic programs and reviews the adequacy of those resources. UPRC does not attempt to direct budgetary processes other than to provide broad general priorities, but it is responsible for the formation and review of policy and procedures in all aspects of University Planning and allocation of resources—with special emphasis on matters of concern to faculty. Academic Technology Committee

The ATC is a standing committee of the Faculty Senate that provides advice, guidance, and support to the Information Technology Services organization of the University, and assures that Western's investment in information technology facilities and resources effectively and efficiently serves the University's strategic activities and the academic needs of students and faculty. The Senate Library Committee

The SLC advises and makes recommendations to the Dean of the Libraries and serves as liaison between the faculty and the Dean of Libraries. This advice concerns policies and procedures relating to the library's development and maintenance of collections, services, facilities and budget so that faculty, students, and staff can effectively and efficiently use the library. The SLC provides it minutes and periodic reports to the Faculty Senate. (See [SLC](#).)
