The DOL CUSTOMER ACCOUNT NUMBER is found on the Washington Driver's License or Identification Card (12 digits) — or if the owner is a business or organization, is the UBI number found on the Master Business License and Registration Certificate (9 digits).

DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES Special License Plate applicants are required to be a registered or co-registered owner or lessee or co-lessee of the vehicle. A fee (and a subagent fee, if applicable) is charged to transfer specialized plates to another vehicle owned by the applicant. You may complete the transfer at any vehicle license office. When the specialized plates are transferred to another vehicle, the plates will assume the registration expiration date of the new vehicle.

- Destroyed, lost or stolen plates may be replaced. A plate fee is charged. Please contact your local vehicle licensing office for fee information.
- For additional LICENSING information, including fees, please contact your local vehicle licensing office.
- A combination of specialized plates is NOT allowed. (For example: A WWU plate on the front and a Mariner plate on the rear of a vehicle.)

The Department of Licensing computer system issues the plates in numerical order when the transaction is finalized. You will know immediately the number of your Western Washington University License plates; the actual plates will be mailed within two business days.

- Complete the form above. If it isn't your plate renewal time, you can still purchase a new plate at any point during your registration period.
- Visit <https://fortress.wa.gov/dol/dolprod/vehoffices/> to locate your local licensing office and their hours of operation.
- Mail or bring the completed form, plus cash or check, to your local licensing office. The price of new plate varies based on your current plates and renewal cycle. Please call a vehicle licensing office for a mock transaction to get exact amounts. For each set of plates purchased or renewed, \$28 goes to WWU student scholarships.
