### Fee

Each application must be accompanied by a check payable to Western Washington University. This is a nonrefundable fee, which will be deposited upon receipt. The entry fee is \$15 for up to 3 entries.

### Awards

Keith Boadwee will choose three winners and 20 honorable mentions to be featured in an exhibition at the Corridor Gallery located in the Tashiro Kaplan Building in Pioneer Square, Seattle, WA. This will also include an opening reception during Seattle's First Thursday Art Walk. The three winners will each have three pieces selected to be shown in the exhibition. The honorable mentions will each have one piece on display. Winners will be notified by April 30, 2010 via email and on the web.

### Eligibility & Conditions

All work must have been completed within the past two years. Maximum dimensions of work is 40"x40". *F Yeah Arts!* reserves the right to reject entries that do not meet these requirements.

### Photography

Western Washington University and *F Yeah Arts!* reserves the right to photograph entries and the exhibition for the purpose of documentation.

### Delivery of Work

Selected pieces must be received by June 14, 2010 and retrieved by July 31, 2010. Shipped artwork must include return postage. All pieces must be framed/prepared by the artist and ready for hanging upon delivery.

### Opening Reception

*F Yeah Arts!* would like to extend an invitation to an opening reception on Thursday, July 1st from 5-9pm in conjunction with First Thursday Art Walk. The exhibition will run from July 1-30, 2010 and will be open Fridays and Saturdays 12-5pm.

It is an advertised nationwide call for entries, and the professional manner and presentation of the pieces is a top priority. We are a dedicated team of artists committed to the task of presenting and promoting art in our community.

## Corridor Gallery

Corridor Gallery is located at TK Studios in the Tashiro Kaplan Building in Pioneer Square, Seattle. Corridor is a cooperative space run under the auspices of a non-profit, and comprises the corridors and common area serving TK work-only studios and galleries. Due to its location in the TK building, Corridor can receive hundreds of visitors during its receptions on First Thursday art walks. The gallery is also open to the public two days a week.

## Juror

*Keith Boadwee* teaches at the San Francisco Art Institute and at the California College of the Arts, and has been widely acclaimed for his controversial and progressive style. He studied at the University of California, Los Angeles in the late 80's, where he worked with Paul McCarthy and Chris Burden. He has shown work in the Venice Biennale, the New Museum's Bad Girls exhibition in New York, and Los Angeles' Portfolio of Photography curated by Cindy Sherman.
