Name of body of water	Details
bay	<p>Definition: An inlet of the ocean partly surrounded (and sheltered) by land NOTE: A bay may be quite large, but does not have to be.</p> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/>
ocean	<p>Definition: A very large body of salt water.</p> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/>
inlet	<p>Definition: A narrow opening of the ocean or sea into the land.</p> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/>
river	<p>Definition: A long, or large, stream of fresh water flowing from higher to lower ground. NOTE: A river usually flows into a lake or ocean.</p> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/>
