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SPECIAL REMINDER

This coming year's construction on the south end of campus will be one of the busiest times since the mid 60's and mid 70's. The Campus Services Facility, Student Recreation Center, and Communications Building are major facilities in the south end of campus that are in differing phases of design or construction. Site development and the provision of utilities for these projects must be carefully phased to avoid interference with one another and their respective impacts to the campus community, particularly parking and circulation.

During the next year, the most major improvements will occur along Bill McDonald Parkway, 21st Street, and South College Drive. Projects include:

- Sidewalk improvements at the Bill McDonald Parkway/South College Drive intersection.
- Construction of the second underground storm water detention vault south of the women's fast pitch softball field. This second vault completes the upgraded storm water system for south campus.
- Excavation of a new utility tunnel from the pedestrian pathway close to the "Steamworks" sculpture and west to the service road.
- Continued construction of the new utility tunnel in the service road from West College Drive to Parks Hall.

As with all our campus construction projects, safety is our number one priority. The University's project management team works closely with the University departments of Public Safety (Police) and Environmental Health and Safety to ensure the safest work environment possible. In addition, assurances are made that the safest work procedures are adhered to by the contractors and consultants. Due to the proximity of these projects to each other, even stronger safety oversight will be given.

While we'll work to minimize the impacts to your daily routine, we ask for your continued patience as we enter an exciting time in our campus development.
