

Directions to WWU

Bellingham, Washington, a city of 75,000 located 60 miles south of Vancouver, British Columbia, and 90 miles north of Seattle; the campus overlooks Bellingham Bay and is an hour drive to the snow-capped Cascade Mountains.

Directions

From the south:

- From Interstate 5, take exit 252
- Turn left off the ramp onto S. Samish Way
- Turn left at the stop light onto N. Samish Way
- Stay in the left lane and go over the freeway
- At the second light, turn left onto Bill McDonald Parkway/Byron Ave. – There will be a Wendy's and a 76 Station on your left.
- Drive on Bill McDonald Parkway for just over 1 mile and continue straight through the stop light (you will still be on the Bill McDonald Parkway)
- The Campus Services Building will be the first building on the right after the intersection

From the north:

- From Interstate 5 going south, take exit 252 and get in the right lane
- Turn right off the ramp onto N. Samish Way, and get into the left lane
- At the next light, turn left onto Bill McDonald Parkway/Byron Ave. – There will be a Wendy's and a 76 Station on your left.
- Drive on Bill McDonald Parkway for just over 1 mile and continue straight through the stop light (you will still be on the Bill McDonald Parkway)
- The Campus Services Building will be the first building on the right after the intersection

Parking Information

Parking permits may be obtained at the Visitor Information kiosks M-F 7:15 am - 8 pm, or inside the Campus Services Building M-F 7:30 am - 4:30 pm. No permit is required in (south campus) gravel C lots between 5 pm and 7 am weekdays, or on weekends. There is a \$1 an hour charge for parking after 5 pm and on weekends in designated lots, which have blue machines that accept cash, coins, or credit/debit cards. Parking meters require payment all hours, the fee is \$2 an hour.
