

Wind & Percussion Jury FAQs

Who?

Fall juries are for third, fourth, fifth (sixth? seventh?!) year undergraduate music majors and non-majors enrolled in private lessons, as well as graduate students. First and second year students – do not sign up unless you are doing an Upper Division Jury!

When?

Tuesday, December 12th, 2006

Where?

Brass and Percussion Juries, and Upper Division Juries, in the Concert Hall
Woodwind Juries in room 24

How do I sign up?

Sign up sheets are located on the LL2 Bulletin Board by the elevator. Sign up for the earliest available time, after confirming the date and time with your accompanist. Sign up ***in pencil***.

What do I need to have a successful jury?

Copies of a filled-out jury form - Jury forms are available in the main office or on the website at <http://www.wvu.edu/music/htm/current.html>. Type or write legibly, and bring seven copies to your jury (for an Upper Division Jury, bring fifteen).

Proper attire – You don't need to wear a tux or prom dress; just don't show up in jeans and sneakers. Make your mother proud and wear that tie she gave you for your last birthday... around your neck.

Don't be on time, be early! – Some juries take longer than others, so be around the jury room 7-10 minutes before your scheduled time, ready to play!

Copies of music – This is not required, but is encouraged! Bring a few clean copies of your scores for the faculty.
