To receive a recommendation for state of Washington certification, students must complete the “teacher certification” program, including the content methods course Sec 426, which is offered by the Department of Secondary Education 1) as a part of the undergraduate Bachelor of Arts degree, or 2) as a post-baccalaureate program, or 3) as a part of the Master’s in Teaching degree. Completion of this combined major leads to an endorsement in social studies. Courses required for a state teaching endorsement must be completed with a grade of C (2.0) or better.
