



Sodexo Multicultural Achievement Program (MAP) Dining Services Scholarship 2008-2009

The Sodexo Multicultural Achievement Program (MAP) Dining Services Scholarship is an important component of the university's efforts to engage students living on campus in multicultural leadership opportunities within the residence halls. The purpose of the scholarship is to assist students who have demonstrated their commitment to diversity and who can assist Residence Life in their efforts to promote diversity. The Sodexo MAP Dining Services Scholarships are up to \$1,000 per academic year and will be divided evenly over all quarters of enrollment. This award is a partial waiver that will help to cover the cost of an undergraduate's housing and meal plan. Recipients may compete for awards in subsequent years by reapplying each year.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must demonstrate solid academic abilities, strong leadership qualities and a commitment to assisting Residence Life in their efforts to promote diversity. Applicants must:

1. live in University Residences
2. have a meal plan
3. complete a minimum of 12 credits per quarter
4. maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.00 for every quarter funds are received
5. show a commitment to diversity

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete a Sodexo MAP Dining Services Scholarship Application form.
2. Provide a personal statement.
3. Provide a written statement describing how you will contribute to multiculturalism in the Residence Halls.
4. Provide a current transcript (*unofficial is acceptable*).

Please submit a completed scholarship application. The application packet consists of the completed application form, a written personal statement, the written statement describing how you will contribute to multiculturalism in the Residence Halls, and grade transcripts.

Application deadline is April 30, 2008. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all application materials are on file in Student Outreach Services by the deadline. An April 30, 2008 postmark is acceptable. The committee will not accept incomplete applications. Submit your scholarship application packets to:
