This scholarship is awarded to first-generation-to-college students. It is renewable annually to students who demonstrate academic progress. Award amounts vary but are approximately \$500 per year. Recipients must demonstrate financial need.</p>

You should include such information as income, unusual hardships or expenses, employment, and efforts you have made to finance your education.</p> <p><b>LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION</b>            Submit a letter of recommendation from a faculty member that addresses the specific scholarship for which you are applying.</p>
