Huxley Annual Celebration of Graduation
2 pm, June 14, 2008, Performing Arts Center Main Stage

Huxley has an annual tradition of recognizing recent and prospective graduates at a special celebration each June. This year's Graduation Celebration honors Huxley graduates from Fall 2007 through Fall 2008. Although Huxley's Celebration is the same day as Western's spring quarter Commencement, our event is unrelated. Huxley's Spring Quarter Graduates who are eligible may attend either or both events. Items of Note for Huxley Celebration

PARTICIPATION: Those eligible to participate in Huxley's 2008 Celebration are Huxley students graduating Fall 2007 through Fall 2008. Huxley's Dean's Office will email eligible participants a Participation Form on April 18. GUEST TICKETS: A decision will be made about whether to use tickets for the graduation celebration on May 18. Emails about the decision will be sent to those who have registered for the graduation celebration..

SCHEDULE: The Huxley celebration starts promptly at 2 pm. The event and reception last about an hour and a half. Our keynote speaker has not been determined yet. The program also includes recognition of student award winners, a student speaker, and presentation of tree saplings to the participants. The no-cost reception after the program gives participants a chance to introduce their family and guests to the Huxley community.

NO-COST EVENT: Huxley's Celebration is free for students and guests. Participant attire ranges from business-casual to dressy (No caps and gowns). Huxley offsets the event cost with the sale of celebration invitations and Huxley Gear (Sweatshirts, T-shirts, etc.). Participants can buy invitations in Huxley's Office in May.

HUXLEY GEAR: Sweatshirts, t-shirts, etc., with the Huxley logo are offered for sale in the Dean's Office throughout the academic year and at the graduation celebration.
