

TEACHER EDUCATION P-12 PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND HEALTH PROGRAM
Admission Requirements

Prerequisites to Admission:

1. Minimum of one quarter in the P.E. program
2. Must have received a passing grade ("C" or better) in KIN 301, KIN 308, P.E. 340, and BIO 348.
3. Must meet minimum requirements for the Woodring College of Education, including passing all sections of the WEST-B exam.

Application/Portfolio Requirements: Due in early October. See advisor for specific date.

1. Three **official** application reference letters from individuals (no relatives) in leadership positions, one of whom must be from someone who has supervised you while working with children and/or youth. *Please note: It is your responsibility to obtain reference letters and include them when you submit all materials. Applications will not be considered without all three letters. With the official reference letter, provide the reference writer with an envelope addressed to you. Please remind your reference writers to sign across the seal on the back of the envelope. You are not to open this confidential document.*
2. Transcripts, including high school and all colleges attended.
3. Written work from KIN 301—Survey of Kinesiology, PE and Health (with evaluation sheet).

If you are registered in KIN 301 in fall quarter, hand in the required written examples of your work when they are returned to you at the end of the quarter.

4. A complete official admissions application.
5. Two page essay addressing:
 - a. Why the teaching career was chosen.
 - b. Previous experiences which indicate future teaching success.
 - c. Personal contributions that can be made to the field/profession.
 - d. Personal long-range plans/goals.

Formal Interview: (throughout fall quarter)

1. Twenty to thirty minute interview with a P.E. faculty member and possibly another education professional.
2. Ten minute presentation (and five minutes of questioning) which addresses:
 - a. A current issue in education (you select the issue).
 - b. Strategies and ideas on how it can be resolved.

You will be notified of your status by the end of fall quarter. Those selected will be allowed to continue in the program and take P.E. 341 winter quarter.
