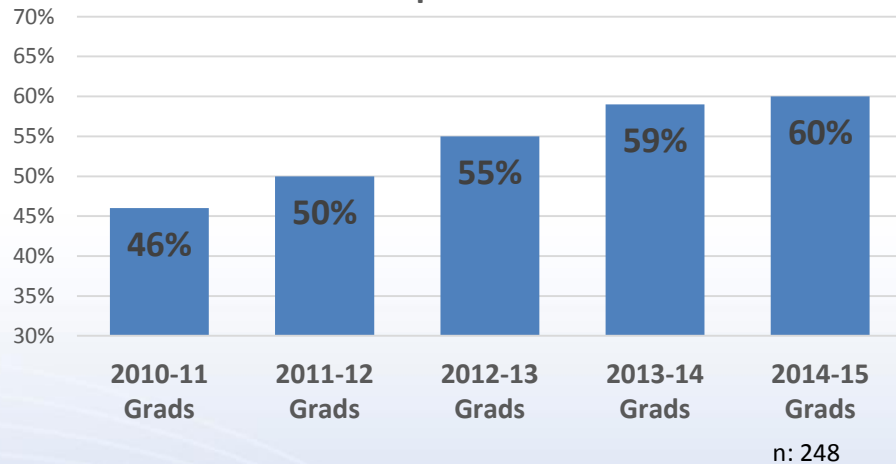


2014-15 Graduate Employment Status

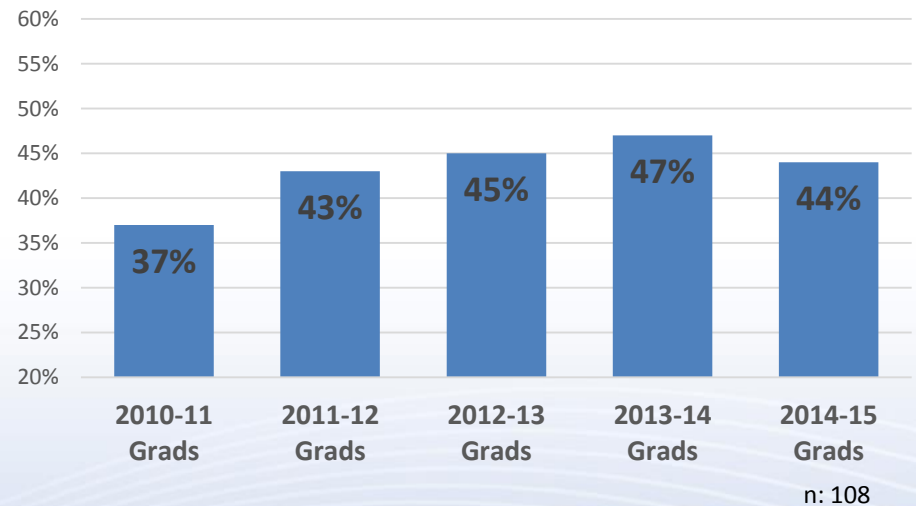
Each year the Career Services Center surveys graduating seniors within six months of graduation to ascertain majors, job titles, employers, salary information and whether they participated in an internship. Of a total of 3,161 Bachelor degree recipients, 43% (n= 1350) responded to the survey. Data for the 2014-15 year showed those with internship experience (1) found work more quickly and (2) with an average higher starting salary - about 10% over their peers without internship experience.

Data: Of the 1,350 survey respondents, 410 responded to the question, "Did you have an internship?." 248 responded Yes 162 responded No 108 responded either "Yes, Paid for Credit" or "Yes, Paid, No Credit"
