

## HAROLD AND LYLA LANT SCHOLARSHIP

The Harold and Lyla Lant Scholarship Endowment was established to encourage and reward students pursuing a career as a lawyer. It is the intent of the scholarship to continue Harold Lant's legacy of intellect, dedication and integrity within the law profession.

A minimum of a \$1,500 scholarship is available and will be awarded to the most qualified student in the **2019-2020** school year.

### Eligibility and Criteria:

1. The Lant Scholarship shall be awarded to students who are pursuing careers as lawyers.
2. Only students enrolled at WWU who will graduate no later than August 2020 are eligible.
3. Academic performance, leadership, extracurricular activities, ethics, and integrity are factors that shall weigh heavily in the selection process.

### Application Procedures (provide the following materials):

1. Completed scholarship application form (available online at the Career Services Website: <http://www.wwu.edu/careers/scholarships.shtml>. Also Available in Old Main 380, Academic Advising Center).
2. Personal statement of no more than three pages (double-spaced) addressing the scholarship criteria, including why you want to go to law school.
3. One letter of recommendation from a professional reference (professor or instructor, supervisor, coach, advisor) who knows your intellect, maturity, character, personal circumstances, and/or experience. (No more than 2 letters allowed, and not from this scholarship committee.)
4. Copy of your LSAT score.
5. Unofficial copy of your WWU transcript.
6. Optional: proof of application to law school.

**Deadline:** January 31, 2020
